- 3. An order of the Honourable Court directing that the Meeting be convened by giving a twenty-eight (28)-day notice period, which notice shall be furnished by way of publication in two (2) national daily newspapers;
- 4. An order directing that a copy of the Scheme Document incorporating the notice of the meeting, the Scheme and the Explanatory Statement be sent to the email addresses or the postal addresses of the shareholders appearing in the Register of Members of the Applicant;
 - 5. An order of the Honourable Court directing that voting at the Meeting will be by poll;
 - 6. An order of the Honourable Court directing that the Scheme Shareholders of the Applicant may participate in the Meeting by proxy by appointing any person as proxy who shall be entitled to vote on their behalf in the manner so directed in the proxy form;
 - 7. An order of the Honourable Court directing that the Meeting be convened such that



Scheme Shareholders of the Applicant entitled to attend and participate in the Meeting may follow the proceedings of the Meeting virtually through any convenient virtual meeting technology platform, including but not limited to Zoom, Skype and Microsoft Teams as the Applicant may deem fit;

- 8. An order of the Honourable Court directing that Mr. Farouk Mohammed Gumel (the Applicant's Chairman) be appointed Chairman of the Meeting or, failing him, any other director of the Applicant appointed in his stead by the shareholders present at the Meeting to act as Chairman;
- 9. An order of the Honourable Court directing the Applicant, if the Scheme is approved at the Meeting by a majority representing not less than three-quarters (3/4) in the value of the shares of the Scheme Shareholders of the Applicant present and voting in person or by proxy, to present the approved Scheme to the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") for its final approval;
 - 10. An order of the Honourable Court directing the Applicant to present the minutes of the court-ordered meeting along with the Applicant's petition for an order of the Honourable Court to sanction the Scheme;
 - 11. An order directing that if the Scheme Shareholders at the Meeting agree to, and approve the Scheme, the minutes of the Court-Ordered Meeting be presented to this Honourable Court for sanction of the Scheme; and



12. For such further or other orders as this Honourable Court may deem fit to make in the circumstances.

AND UPON READING affidavit in support of the motion paper sworn to by Somuyiwa Sonubi, Adult, Male, Christian, Nigeria Citizen and Company Secretary of Union Bank of Nigeria Plc of Stallion Plaza, 36 Marina, Lagos State.


